

**Instructions for the Extemporaneous Compounding of:
Phenoxybenzamine Hydrochloride Suspension 1mg/ml**

Instructions for preparation:

- Using a sterile alcohol wipe, clean the measuring jug, pestle and mortar. Allow to dry.
- Print the required number of labels and leave to one side
- Count out the required number of phenoxybenzamine capsules depending on volume being prepared. **Check.**
- Carefully open each of the capsules and transfer the powder to the mortar. Wear gloves here. Ensure all capsules are empty. **Check.**
- Grind the powder until it is a fine powder and not caked
- Slowly add the Keltrol 0.4%w/v in increments. Mix after each addition until the phenoxybenzamine powder is suspended.
- Transfer to a clean, dry graduated cylinder.
- Rinse the mortar with Keltrol 0.4%w/v and add the rinsings to the graduated cylinder.
- Bring to volume with Keltrol 0.4%w/v. **Check.**
- Transfer to a sterile bottle. Cap and label appropriately.
- Leave to one side for checking. **FINAL CHECK**
